## Becoming a Pharmacy Technician in Newfoundland and Labrador

New Graduates of Accredited Canadian Pharmacy Technician Programs

| Fo register as a pharmacy technician in Newfoundland and Labrador, applicants who are new graduates of a<br>Accredited Canadian pharmacy technician program must meet the following requirements:                    |   |

|  | The applicant must apply for and successfully complete a practical training period, in accordance with NLPB's Practical Training Requirements for Registration as a Pharmacy Technician.  |
|  | The applicant must apply for and successfully complete the NLPB Registration Examination in accordance with NLPB's Registration Examination Interpretation Guide.   |
|  | The applicant must successfully complete both Parts I and II of the Pharmacy Examining Board of Canada PEBC) Qualifying Examination for Pharmacy Technicians.   |
|  | The applicant must provide a certificate of conduct, in accordance with NLPB's Certificate of Conduct Requirements for Registration.  |
| <u>ir</u>  | The applicant must arrange to have an official transcript indicating graduation sent from the educational nstitution where they completed their pharmacy technician education directly to NLPB. Alternatively, a otarized copy of the applicant's diploma may be mailed or hand-delivered to the NLPB office. |
|  | The applicant must submit a completed "Application for Registration as a Pharmacy Technician", along with ne appropriate fee and supporting documents including:  |
|  | <ul> <li>A professional liability insurance coverage certificate, indicating current coverage in accordance<br/>with NLPB's Professional Liability Insurance Requirements for Registration; and</li> </ul>  |
|  | <ul> <li>Government-issued photo identification in accordance with NLPB's Photo Identification<br/>Requirements for Registration.</li> </ul>  |
| Once the above steps have been completed and all documentation has been received, the applicant's file will be reviewed to ensure that all requirements for registration in Newfoundland and Labrador have been met. |   |

The applicant will be notified once a final decision has been made.

PLEASE NOTE:

Depending on the province in which education was completed, applicants may be required to demonstrate English language proficiency in accordance with NLPB's English Language Proficiency Requirements for Registration.
